Dave Coughran reported 326 current wards on probation; 50 in Placement, 84 on work project, 72 in Wraparound, 9 on home supervision and 18 in Drug Court with RAFT.

The population of the Juvenile Detention Facility has been ranged from 19 to 31.

AB 12 and AB 212 (amendment) have been passed in the state extending foster care financial services beyond the age of 18. Foster youth can now receive foster youth services until the age of 21 given they are following the rules and regulations.
