



Remote Appearances: Family Law and Child Support (DCSS)

Evidentiary Hearings Written Notice Requirements

Event Types

- Contempt Hearings and Trials
- Default Judgments
- Domestic Violence & Gun Violence Restraining Order Hearings and Trials
- Evidentiary Hearings (*FL & DCSS*)
- Termination of Parental Rights Hearings and Trials
- Trials (*FL & DCSS*)

Process

FORMS:

To notice: File & serve JCC RA-010 *Notice of Remote Appearance* & Local Form PL-CW010A *Attachment to Notice of Remote Appearance*

- ✓ Parties must either complete the *Declaration of Notice* on RA-010 or file proof of service with the forms.

To oppose: File & serve JCC RA-015 *Opposition to Remote Proceeding at Evidentiary Hearing or Trial*

DEADLINES:

If the hearing is set on MORE than 15 court days notice:

- ✓ Notice 10 court days before the hearing
- ✓ Oppose 5 court days before the hearing

If the hearing is set on LESS than 15 court days notice:

To notice: By the applicable deadline -

- ✓ 5 court days before the hearing
- ✓ *If the notice to appear remotely is by the party asking for the hearing:* With the moving papers
- ✓ *If the notice to appear remotely is by any other party:* By 2 pm the court day before the hearing

To oppose: By noon the court day before the hearing

Evidentiary Hearings Simplified Notice Requirements

Event Types

- Request for Order Hearings (Including any continued hearings following the initial hearing on the R.F.O.)
- Child Support (D.C.S.S) Hearings

Process

FORMS:

- ✓ **To notice:** **NONE.** Parties do not need to file any forms – scheduling a remote appearance online is considered notice to the court.

- ✓ Parties do need to notify/notice the other party 5 court days before the hearing, however proofs of service are not required.

- ✓ **To oppose:** File & serve JCC RA-015 *Opposition to Remote Proceeding at Evidentiary Hearing or Trial*

DEADLINES:

- ✓ Parties must schedule themselves and notice all other parties no later than 1 court day before the hearing.
- ✓ Oppose by noon the court day before the hearing.

Non-Evidentiary Hearings Written Notice Requirements

Event Types

- Fee Waiver Hearings
- Settlement Conferences
- Trial Confirming Conferences
- UCCJEA Hearings

Process

FORMS:

File & serve JCC RA-010 *Notice of Remote Appearance* & Local Form PL-CW010A *Attachment to Notice of Remote Appearance*

- ✓ Parties must either complete the *Declaration of Notice* on RA-010 or file proof of service with the forms.

DEADLINES:

If the hearing is set on MORE than 3 court days notice: Notice 2 court days before the hearing

If the hearing is set on LESS than 3 court days notice: Notice by the applicable deadline -

- ✓ *If the notice to appear remotely is by the party asking for the hearing:* With the moving papers
- ✓ *If the notice to appear remotely is by any other party:* By 2 pm the court day before the hearing

Non-Evidentiary Hearings Simplified Notice Requirements

Event Types

- Emergency Request Hearings
- Family Centered Case Resolution Conferences
- Order Shortening Time Hearings
- Trial Assignment

Process

FORMS:

NONE. Parties do not need to file any notice forms – scheduling a remote appearance online is considered notice to the court.

- ✓ Parties do need to notify/notice the other party, however proofs of service are not required.

DEADLINES:

Parties must schedule themselves and notice all other parties no later than 1 court day before the hearing.
